Statewide Measures

Prop. 2: Bond for School Repairs & Updates

\$10 billion for K-12 schools and community colleges.



Prop. 3: Protect Same-Sex Marriage Rights

Update California constitution to conform to federal law.



Prop. 4: Money for Climate Initiatives

Temporarily fund extreme heat mitigation and fire prevention.



Prop. 5: Make It Easier to Pass Housing Bonds

Lower the voter approval threshold from 1/3 to 55%.



Prop. 6: End Forced Prison Labor

End a vestige of slavery that affects incarcerated people.



Prop. 32: Raise the State Minimum Wage

Bring pay from \$16 to \$18 per hour for most workers.



Prop. 33: Repeal Costa-Hawkins

Allow cities to establish stronger rent control laws.



Prop 34: Limit Nonprofit Political Spending

Target the AIDS Healthcare Foundation for their activism.



Statewide Measures (cont.)

Prop. 35: Tax Managed Health Care Insurance Plans

Increase federal support of Medi-Cal for low-income patients.



Prop. 36: Stiffer Penalties for Nonviolent Crimes

Incarcerate even more people for petty theft and drug use.

Meas. A: Fund Affordable Housing Construction

Repeal and replace existing 1/4-cent sales tax with 1/2-cent sales tax.



Meas. G: Restructure County Governance

Create a CEO with no term limits to oversee budgets & departments.



L.A. City

Meas. DD: Commission to Draw Council Districts

Limit councilmembers' ability to draw their own council districts.



Meas. LL: Commission to Draw LAUSD Districts

Create independent body to redraw school districts every 10 years.
